World Health Organization: Revision of the International Health Regulations, Introductory Note by Gerald Schatz

The Revised WHO Regulations set forth detailed provisions on ways of reporting information on health risks between member States, including provisions applying to international travel, transport, and shipment.

European Court of Human Rights Grand Chamber: *Öcalan v. Turkey*

The Court affirmed the Chamber's findings that the applicant's rights under Article 5 § 3 (right to liberty and security) of the ECHR Convention had been violated. Finding the applicant's access to the case file and his representatives inadequate, the Court also pronounced a violation of Article 6 of the ECHR Convention (right to a fair trial).

United Nations Committee Against Torture: Decision on Communication No. 233/2003, Mr. Ahmed Hussein Kamil Agiza v. Sweden

The U.N. Committee against Torture concluded that Sweden breached Article 3 and 22 of the Convention against Torture and Other Cruel, Inhuman and Degrading Treatment or Punishment. The Committee concluded that the procurement of diplomatic assurances, which provided no mechanism for enforcement, did not suffice to protect the applicant against the manifest risk of torture.

International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda Appeals Chamber: *Kajelijeli v. The Prosecutor*

The Appeals Chamber stated that "concurrent conviction for individual and superior responsibility in relation to the same count based on the same facts constitutes legal error invalidating the Trial Judgment." For this reason, the Appeals Chamber vacated the Appellant's convictions insofar as they were based on a finding of the Appellant's superior responsibility.

International Centre for Settlement of Investment Disputes: *CMS Gas Transmission Company v. The Argentine Republic*

The Tribunal held, inter alia, that Argentina failed to accord CMS Gas Transmission Company fair and equitable treatment in violation of Article II(2) of the Argentina-U.S. Bilateral Investment Treaty. The Tribunal dismissed CMS's claim for expropriation.
